

Peek-a-Boo Gift Card Holder Tutorial Written by Julie Davison

Supplies:

- 3 1/4" x 10" Old Olive cardstock, scored at 2" and 6"
- 3 ½" x 7 ½" Cherry Cobbler cardstock, scored at 3 ½" and 7"
- 3" x 3" Old Olive cardstock
- 2 ¾" x 4 ¼" Very Vanilla cardstock
- 1 ¼" x 3 ¼" Holly Jolly DSP
- 12" Very Vanilla ¼" Grosgrain Ribbon
- Contempo Christmas
- Word Play stamp set
- Old Olive & Cherry Cobbler markers
- 1 ¾" Circle Punch
- 23/8" Scallop Circle Punch
- Ornament Punch
- Sticky Strip & SNAIL Adhesive



Peek-a-Boo Gift Card Holder

Directions:

- 1. Score Cherry Cobbler and Old Olive cardstock as indicated in supply list. Fold on all score lines. Punch a 1 ¾" Circle from the Cherry Cobbler cardstock as shown. Insert the punch all the way and center from right to left.
- 2. Apply Sticky Strip along the skinny edge of the Cherry Cobbler cardstock and two pieces on both sides of the 2" flap of the Old Olive cardstock. Fold both pieces up to create an Old Olive pocket with a flap over it and a Cherry Cobbler sleeve.
- 3. Punch a 1 ¾" Circle from the 3" x 3" Old Olive cardstock. Line up the 2 3/8" Scallop Circle Punch over the 1 ¾" Circle and punch a scallop frame. Adhere the frame over the opening on the Cherry Cobbler sleeve.
- 4. Use markers to ink the "Tidings of Comfort and Joy" stamp from the Word Play stamp set. Punch out with the 1 ¾" Circle Punch.
- 5. Slide the Old Olive pocket with flap into the Cherry Cobbler sleeve. Apply adhesive to the back of the "Tidings of Comfort & Joy" punch out. Line it up in the window on the Cherry Cobbler sleeve as a guide to adhere the circle to the Old Olive pocket. Tie a ribbon around the bottom of the gift card sleeve.
- 6. Decorate the inside of the gift card holder using the Contempo Christmas stamp set and Holly Jolly DSP.
